HISTORY

The Alumni Association for the Littleton Police Citizen's Academy was a planned extension of the Academy under the direction of Chief Gary Maas and formulated in the spring of 2000. With the LPD sponsorship of Lt. Ed Tardy, PO Dan Stocking and Crime Analyst Sheree Matousek, a team of Academy graduates began the process of developing the nonprofit Alumni Association.

By November 1, 2000 the process was complete and the newly named Littleton Citizen Police Academy Alumni Association was filed with the State of Colorado and the IRS. However, since the Association is not a citizen police organization, it was renamed as the Littleton Police Citizen Academy Alumni Association (LPCAAA).

Our logo was fashioned after the police shield for the Littleton Police Department.

In addition to the development of the Bylaws and Articles of Incorporation it was necessary to present the Association through the Mission Statement listed on the face page of our website.

Funding is provided through membership and private citizen donations and is used to facilitate LPD programs and department needs.

Our first newsletter was published in March 2001 and our website has been on line since January 2010.
